The Project: We are looking for 60-100 participants to take a 13 weeks visual-storytelling journey in the co-creation of a story archive which will culminate in the production of 10 to 13 digital mural paintings which will be printed and installed in the Richmond Underpass between Horton and York. The idea of painting a background is still on.

During the 13 weeks you will be given a series of storytelling activities, resources, workshops, "homeworks", prompts and platforms to explore your story and the story emerging in your community during this quarantine.

To be eligible to participate:

- Be able to commit to the 13 weeks and submit all the storytelling activities. Each week you are given storytelling activities you can complete in at least 30 mins to 1hr.
- Be willing to participate fully and openly in personal storytelling (no experience in storytelling required).
- Be respectful to yourself and others embracing with openness other peoples experiences, ethnic backgrounds and stories.
